Your letter to Klaus Kleinfeld has been referred to me. I note that you sent Klaus a copy of three CAPS documents: an appeal against the Wagerup refinery's 2013 licence renewal; an appeal against amendments to the works approval for the refinery VOC reduction project; and a submission on the refinery noise amelioration plan.

What these documents demonstrate is that CAPS, like any other organisation or individual, has had the opportunity to participate in the public processes established by government when dealing with these matters. While we may disagree with the content of these documents, just as CAPS may disagree with the content of Alcoa submissions, this is democracy at work and I encourage you to continue participating and putting forward your point of view through these processes.
