DER 2017/2064 – Groundwater Contamination


We would be happy to have a list of sites and then determine which sites we would like our request to apply to. The Basic Summary of Records which can be applied for under the Contaminated Sites Act does not, from our review, include the information we have requested under FOI. Can you please confirm if you will provide us with a list of sites, and then from that list, allow CAPS to determine which sites we require access to documents? We consider this to be a reasonable and practicable approach to reducing the scope of our application.

DER2017/2066 – Potential breaches by Alcoa at Wagerup Facility

CAPS is prepared to further reduce the scope of our request. In an effort to reduce the scope of our application, CAPS is willing to revise its scope to Alcoa's Wagerup facility.

CAPS is willing to accept the Department's offer to provide printout of ICMS reports only, but request that this be for the period from 1 January **2014** (instead of 1 January 2013) to 1 September 2017. We do not agree the timeframe suggested of 1 January 2016. This is because we are concerned with the general conduct of Alcoa and the Department's regulation of Alcoa over the last few years.
