APPLICATION FOR A WORKS APPROVAL UNDER THE *ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986* – DECISION TO GRANT

I refer to the Community Alliance for Positive Solutions Inc. (CAPS) submissions dated 13 December 2017 and 11 January 2018 and the fifty submissions lodged by CAPS on 12 January 2018 on behalf of other individuals. The submissions are in respect of the work approval application submitted by Alcoa of Australia Limited for the construction of an oxalate bioremoval facility at the Wagerup Refinery.

I wish to advise you that a works approval under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) has been granted for the above premises. The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) will advertise the decision on its website, www.dwer.wa.gov.au. The works approval is subject to conditions.

In accordance with section 102(3) of the EP Act, if you are concerned about or object to the specification of any condition in the works approval you may lodge an appeal with the Minister for Environment within 21 days from the date on which the decision is made.
